

/// PRIVACY POLICY (English Translation / V0.1)

Thank you for visiting Something Records. Here you will be informed in the following which of your personal data is collected/used and why.

The website www.Something-Records.com does not use cookies or other means of monitoring user behavior. Every time you visit this website, only the service provider (provider of storage space for this website) stores some information for a certain period of time. This data could be the IP address and the website from which the visit was made, etc. Something Records does not use data beyond what is absolutely necessary for a normal business transaction (plus any possibly ordered newsletter). So there is no further procedure or further processing of your data. For example there is no address trading, profiling, location tracking or similar operations.

To enable communication by electronic means, Something Records needs your e-mail address. This will be stored within a company internal e-mail program. Included within any e-mail are things like IP address, date, time, browser, operation system, etc., but this data is not constantly under observation and won't be checked / read out, but is still an integral part of any e-mail you send electronically somewhere. Here, this data is almost only used by Something Records and will not be forwarded to any business partners, companies or to others.

Personal details are also saved when sending an e-mail. As you voluntarily provide this information by yourself, your consent is and will be supposed. Telephone numbers & phone calls are not recorded or saved.

E-mails are deleted from time to time should they no longer be service the communication related for trading articles offered on this website.

In order to facilitate the communication, your e-mail address will be needed (possibly including name / complete or partial). Should a trade of articles then come together with Something Records, only necessary data will be collected and stored offline in an in-house text processing program / book keeping. This data is for example: Address, delivery address, goods and monetary values, telephone number. This data may also be shared with external processors such as accountants, auditors, authorized authorities such as tax-offices, etc.

You have the **right and the opportunity** to request information about your existing data at any time.



1) General

Below you will be informed about the protection of your personal data and privacy. This privacy policy is intended to explain the data processing of Something Records (via the website www.something-records.com) Contact and location is: Something Records, Feldstr.13, 38667 Bad Harzburg, Germany. Data will only be collected and used for the purpose of trade articles offered on the above mentioned website, as well as your request for news and communication regarding company-related inquiries, wishes/requests or any other conclusion of a contract (licensing, sale of music, etc.)

2) Data by launching Something-Records

Each time the website is launched, it automatically gets information like

- Informationen about the operating system & browser
- IP address
- Date & time
- Name of the URL of the called file
- Website from which the user came
- Website called by the user's system at Something Records.

The legal basis for this temporary storage is Art. 6.(1) Letter f, DSGVO / GDPR. The purpose of this data processing is to enable a functional and working website. For this purpose, e.g. the IP address remain stored for the duration of the stay and the session. This storage (possibly also in log files) is automatic, and serves the functionality of the website. Storages are not regularly controlled or abused for other promotional purpose, advertisements, marketing, ect. When launching Something Records website, no cookies, tracking tools or other monitorings are made. The collected data is usually deleted after a short time (eg: at the end of the session, expiration of the storage duration of the log files). This process takes place automatically and the user has no influence or right to this. You will find on Something Records,



pages & links which refer to third parties and other websites. The scope of this privacy policy ends when you leave Something Records and Something has no control and is not responsible for the content or any other things of such external linked websites.

3) Data processing in the initiation and execution of an ordering process

In order to place an order through Something Records, it is assumed that the customer expresses a purchase request including personal data via e-mail or an other contact form. Registration is not possible. Thus, customer-related data is not further stored in a database, except the necessary for the processing / storage in the e-mail program, writing an invoice, accounting, shipping, etc. The customer can always request his existing data. The e-mail address is needed to enable the communication of the order. To fulfil a contract, customer-related data is transmitted to a transport company, which delivers the goods. They are obliged to treat your data confidentially and to use it only for the purpose of delivery. Furthermore, customer-related data is deposited where payments are made (PayPal or Bank transfer). Your data will only be used if this is legally necessary. In addition, your data may be viewed by third parties in the course of doing business, should this also be necessary (tax advisor, accounting, fulfillment of a public-interest task, tax office, etc.)

4) Data processing - Newsletter / Something Records relevant advertising

The customer can order a newsletter. The only personal information required is a working e-mail address. At irregular intervals, the user then receives news about new releases of Something artists and label appearances. The data of newsletter subscribers will not be forwarded or misused for any other purpose and will be used exclusively for sending (BCC / anonymous blind copy) to the customer. Otherwise, no further advertising will be switched / sent, and the customer can unsubscribe from the newsletter at any time. Should an e-mail address be no longer working, or have been deleted by the user, it will be irrevocably deleted from the mailing list of Something Records.

5) Links

On this website are Weblinks (f.e. to Youtube or Musicshops). Something Rec is not in any case responsible for those external contents. The Privacy Policy ends by leaving the website. If you have doubts about your privacy, don't click on these links.

6) Your rights at a glance

You are entitled to rights which you can request from Something Records should the personal data concerned be available at Something Records.

- Information law: You may request the following data and information: processing purposes, category of personal data, category of recipients of the disclosed data, planned duration, etc. Criteria for determining the retention period of this data, -the origin of the data (should these not come from you).
- Right to rectification: You have a right of rectification and the like. Completing your data should be incorrect or incomplete.
- Right to delete: You can have your data deleted immediately if, e.g. the following reasons are present:
 - The data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, - Missing legal basis, - Revocation of consent and objection to the processing, - Illegal processing, etc.The right to erasure does not exist: - where processing is required, for example: fulfillment of a legal obligation governed by Union law or to perform a task of public interest or in the exercise of official authority which has been entrusted to the controller. - For reasons of public interest in the field of public health. - In the public interest archival purposes (historical, research purposes, etc.). - For the enforcement, exercise and defense of legal claims.
- Data transferability: You can receive your data in a common, machine-readable format. In addition, you have the right to have the data transmitted to another person in charge, should no liberties and rights of other persons be affected. This right is not allowed should the data, the performance of a public task which is in the public interest, or the exercise of public power, be necessary.
- Right to restriction: You may request the right to restrict the processing of the data should: - You deny the accuracy of the data for a period of time that allows the controller to verify the data. - The processing is unlawful and in the course of which you require a restriction of the data. - The data controller no longer needs the data for the purposes of the processing, but the data subject requires them for the purposes of enforcing, pursuing or defending legal claims. - Or if you have filed an objection against the processing in accordance with Art 21 (1) DSGVO / GDPR, and have not yet determined whether the legitimate reasons of the person responsible outweigh your reasons.
- Right to complain: You may appeal to a regulator of your usual place of residence, or to the competent authority of the polluter, if you believe that the processing of your personal data by Something Records violates DSGVO / GDPR.
- Right of objection: You can invoke the general right of objection at any time if you wish to object to the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 6 (1) (e) of the DSGVO / GDPR and if there are grounds of overriding importance arising from your personal and a particular situation.
